On May 26, 2019 municipal elections will be held

Are you a foreigner (without Spanish nationality)?

Do you know what to do to be able to vote?



If I am a foreigner (without Spanish nationality) how can I vote?

In the case of the following municipal elections, they are entitled to vote:

- EU countries citizens.
- National citizens of **Bolivia, Cape Verde, Chile, Colombia, Korea, Ecuador, Iceland, Norway, New Zealand, Paraguay, Peru and Trinidad and Tobago.**
- If you are not a national of any of the country above, your country does not have a reciprocal agreement with Spain and, therefore, you can not register for the electoral census.

Requirements for registering EU countries

- Be at least 18 years old on the day of the vote.
- Be a registered resident of Roda de Berà
- Have an identity document.

Non-EU countries

Bolivia, Cape Verde, Chile, Colombia, Korea, Ecuador, Iceland, Norway, New Zealand, Paraguay, Peru and Trinidad and Tobago.

- Be at least 18 years old on the day of the vote.
- Be a registered resident of Roda de Berà
- Be in possession of the residence permit in Spain.
- Have legally resided in the Spanish territory the time required in the corresponding agreement (3 years in the case of Norway and 5 years for the rest of the countries). This requirement can be justified by providing a residence certificate issued by the police Station.
- Have a foreigner identity card.



Deadline for registering

- EU countries: 30 January 2019
- Non-EU countries: From 1 December 2018 to 15 January 2019
